

Gaonhae Taekwondo School Policy



1. The school operates on a term-to-term basis. A term consists of 10 weeks. The school will be closed on Public Holidays. We may also be closed for Competitions, Gradings, and other Special Events.
2. Class fees are chargeable on a per term or per lesson basis. Class fees are to be paid before the term commencement date.
3. Makeup lessons must be completed within the same term. Any unused lessons beyond this period will be forfeited.
4. Annual membership fees, which cover administration, affiliation, and insurance costs, which may be subject to change each year. The updated fee will be communicated to members prior to renewal.
5. All fees paid are non-transferable and non-refundable. A school credit may be offered in some cases.
6. Uniforms and accessories may be exchanged or returned within 7 days of purchase, provided they are clean and in saleable condition. Refunds for returns will be issued as school credits.
7. The school requires students to wear the appropriate guards when practising kyorugi (sparring). Strictly no guards, no kyorugi (sparring).
8. Gradings are made on personal ability and progressions. Students are graded according to Gaonhae Taekwondo Syllabus.
9. Images and videos captured during training, demonstrations, or competitions are the exclusive property of Gaonhae Taekwondo and may be used for publicity, advertising, or journalism purposes.
10. Personal information collected is used solely for purposes such as fulfilling service obligations, verifying identity, processing payments or credit transactions, and providing related requested services.
11. Students registered with Gaonhae Taekwondo shall abide by the school rules and the rules of Australian Taekwondo.
12. Students participate in classes and activities at their own risk and agree to indemnify Gaonhae Taekwondo against any loss, injury, damage, expense, or liability arising from such participation.
13. While every effort is made to prevent accidents, students register with Gaonhae Taekwondo at their own risk. Gaonhae Taekwondo and its instructors are not liable for any accidents or injuries that may occur.
